White joined the Southwest Florida Community Foundation Board in 2005 and participates in the Finance Committee and Executive Committee, where his financial knowledge is applied to the investment and grants areas. Named by the Consumers' Research Council of America as one of the country's top financial planners since 2005, White is president of Scott White Advisors and is a Certified Financial Planner™, Chartered Financial Consultant and a Chartered Life Underwriter.

White is active as a frequent speaker to nonprofit and professional groups, writes articles for various magazines and newspapers, and has served on the National Committee on Planned Giving's Leave a Legacy committee. He was the founding president of the Planned Giving Council of Lee County and is past president of the Lee County Estate Planning Council.
